Our current smoke detector system, while helpful for large flame and smoke detection, doesn't detect cigarette smoke. It is not always convenient for residents to go outside to smoke, so some end up smoking in their room either tobacco or marijuana (it is legal here in Oregon)—or both! After we got the Cigarette Buster 52 and tested it with the resident present, the room smoking stopped. It was like magic. However, the resident did try to smoke in other rooms that do not have the magic Cigarette Buster. We are looking at installing more of these smoke detectors so that we can be as proactive as possible for fire hazards that start with stealth cigarette smoke.
